❖ The fraternity of Corps of EME, popularly called as 'the EAGLES' is an organization with the best skilled technicians and engineers of Indian Army. A 'Powerhouse of Technology and Innovations', the Corps has proved its mettle in providing effective engineering support to the Weapon Systems and Equipment of the Army in all Wars, Operations Counter Insurgency environment and Exercises since its inception. While EME field workshops provide intimate engineering support to the field Army, the Corps Zone Workshops and Base Workshops undertake higher level preventive, predictive & corrective maintenance tasks as well as product upgrades, indigenization and obsolescence management for various weapon systems and equipment.

❖ The Corps of EME was born on **02 Mar 1943**. However the workforce from then IAOC was formally transferred on **15 Oct 1943**. The EME thus celebrates its Corps day on 15 Oct each yr.
