SCHEME AND SYLLABUS/TRADE TEST SPECIFICATION

The syllabus for written test for a trade will be broadly as that of the NCTVT examination syllabus for that trade. The syllabus for trade test (Practical) will be as per trade test specification of the semi-skilled grade of the relevant grade of Ordnance Factory.

The trade test specification for respective trades is as follows:-

I. MACHINIST

1. Ability to operate all the Machines viz Screw Machines, Mechanical Machines, Spring coiling Machines, Mechanical presses, Hydraulic Presses etc. and to fix die and punch.
2. Ability to check by means of simple go and not go gauges, stop the machine immediately if the article produce beyond the limits.
3. Ability to read the micrometer, vernier, caliper etc.
4. Ability to assist tool setters in fixing die and punches. Should have knowledge of safety precautions.
5. Ability to work on machines of their own without assistance.
6. Ability to carry out simple marking out operations on components from sketches to a tolerance of ± 0.005 ".
7. Ability to grind single pointed tools correctly.
8. Ability to coil on lath or spring coiling machine, helical springs to different length as desired.
9. Ability to make flat springs and test springs as regards "free length". Length under compression and permanent etc.
10. Should have knowledge of different areas of abrasives used for lapping for different jobs and knowledge of the materials used for mapping, recuperator or similar long bore.
11. Ability to lap & polish tools, die and punches etc. upto the tolerance of ± 0.005 ".
12. Ability to read micrometer graduated to 0.0001 "

13. Ability to carry out high class polishing & buffing operations for simple components.
14. Ability to read simple drawings and make calculations.
15. Knowledge of lubricating system of various machines or items of the plant with which he is associated.
16. Knowledge of how to start and stop the shaft and machineries.
17. Ability to climb ladders and work at height and fasten the pieces of beltings with different kinds of belt fasteners, cut and saw the belt.
18. Ability to measure the approximate required length of the beltings and put belts on & off the pulleys.
19. Ability to carry out any other works of similar nature not mentioned above.

II. FITTER GENERAL

1. Ability to start and stop the compressor, pumps & Motors, carry out routine lubrication, observe pressure gauges, take meter reading, control water temperature where necessary.
2. Ability to detect minor running faults with the Compressor, Motor and pumps in his charge.
3. Ability to distinguish between compressor oils and other oils.
4. Ability to pack glands in the pumps and elementary working knowledge of centrifugal pump or ram pumps.
5. Ability to use file and chisel to carry out simple hand operations such as filing, tapping, sawing, screwing, chipping etc. to the tolerance considered reasonable for each operation.
6. Ability to estimate correct length of rivets required and to set up rivets hot or cold by hand or pneumatic hammer and should have working knowledge of various types of rivets and their use.

7. Ability to use scraper/chisels for the purpose of removing scales marks, line scores and small dents from components or raw material, bringing these into a condition suitable for inspection.
8. Ability to grind simple tools, scrapers, chisel etc. for own use.
9. Ability to read simple drawings and mark-off correctly the centre of holes to be drilled and straight lines on the components with appropriate tools including vernier/ height guage etc. for carrying out simple operations such as drilling, shaping, planning or drilling and boring.
10. Ability to take simple measurement direct from existing plant or store and transcribe them to a fresh components.
11. Ability to carry out simple assembly jobs of repetitive nature and should have knowledge of various components used in a particular store under assembly.
12. Ability to read simple blue prints or take measurements using a foot rule and calipers (internal and external)
13. Ability to carry out simple fitting operations such as fitting, chipping, reaming, tapping or screw cutting by hand taps and dies.
14. Elementary ability to use simple workshop machines such as that required for drilling and rough grinding on emery stone.
15. Ability to read micrometer and vernier and other suitable instruments normally connected with this trade.
16. Must have elementary knowledge of working of refrigeration compressor, blower and other equipments in air-conditioning plants. Ability to start and stop air-conditioning plants in proper sequence.
17. Ability to read voltmeter, Thermometer, Hydrometer & record pressure temperature, relative humidity etc.

18. Ability to carry out minor repair of refrigeration compressor, Cooling tower, blowers, descaling of condenser tubes, chilled water system of AC plant and inter cooler of Air compressor using descaling compounds.
19. Ability to detect leakage of refrigerant in Air conditioning plant and take measures to prevent loss of refrigerant from the system.
20. Must carry tools, spare parts and job pertaining to his own work weighing 20 Kg (Approx).
21. In addition to these ability to carry out any other work of similar nature.

20. EXAMINER

The candidates for the above post will be considered from either A or B above to the extent of earmarked vacancy of the respective trades.

21. ELECTRICIAN

1. Ability to connect up all types of wiring (lighting & power circuits upto 650V) commonly adopted in the establishment including laying and wiring of telephone connections & other miscellaneous items and maintenance thereof and working knowledge of OH line maintenance upto 650 V, including light, service connections. Conversant with use of safety appliance and protective equipments while working in electrical systems and installations.
2. Ability to connect AC/DC electric motors with starter. Knowledge of principles of operation and maintenance of storage batteries. Wiring of low & medium voltage armatures and filed coils and stators for preparing of AC/DC motors/machines.
3. Ability to make H.T. and L.T. cable joints in PILC, PVC and XLPE cables. Knowledge of cable joint boxes, joining tools and plumbing and soldering materials.
4. Ability to select correct sizes of fuzes and wires, overhaul switch gears of furnaces and electrical machines, make simple power calculations and do soldering jobs.
5. Should be able to use a Meggar and similar electrical instruments. Conversant with Earth connection and earth testing for domestic and industrial appliances as per I.E. Rules and protective measures.
6. Ability to read simple electrical drawings (power & control circuit) and to work as per the drawings.

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7. Working knowledge of transformer, LT/HT Switchgear and other substation equipment. Ability to prepare log sheets and make necessary calculations.
8. Knowledge of the relevant I.S. Code of practice and I.E. Rules, particularly relating to General Safety Requirements. General conditions relating to supply & use of energy, Electric supply lines, systems and apparatus for low and medium voltage and overhead lines, underground cables and generating stations. Must be conversant with first-aid & resuscitation in case of electrical accidents. Should be able to deal with electrical fires.
9. Should be able to lift and carry appliances/tools upto 20Kgs without any external help.
10. Should keep his work place and surrounding neat and tidy.
11. Should perform any other related task assigned by staff.

FITTER ELECTRONICS:

1. Ability to read electrical ladder diagrams, electronic circuit diagrams, logic diagrams and wiring diagrams.
2. Ability to read and understand data books and reference manuals of analog and digital electronic devices and components
3. Possess knowledge of thyristor, drives, memory devices, integrated circuits.
4. Ability to trace, troubleshoot, repair and maintain various electronic circuits, printed circuit boards, drive circuits etc.
5. Ability to carry out electronic component testing and soldering/desoldering works.
6. Be conversant with the use of various general purpose electronic testing and measuring equipments like oscilloscopes, multimeters, power supply units, IC testers and LCR meters.

22. MILLWRIGHT

1. Ability to use a file and a chisel and carry out simple hand operations such as filing, tapping, sawing, screwing and chipping etc. by hand tools to the tolerances considered reasonable for such operations.

2. Should have elementary knowledge of handling machines i.e. stripping and assembling simple machine parts.

23. HEAT TREATMENT OPERATOR

1. Ability to harden and temper, large and small components in batches or separately, to meet hardness specifications as well as ability to locally harden and temper important components where required, at different hardness figures.
2. Ability to heat all types of small cuttings tool, milling cutters, press tool fixings and gauges made from straight carbon, alloy or high speed steels without distortion or cracking.
3. Ability to operate modern types of furnaces including salt bath furnace used for heat treatment.
4. Knowledge of quenching mediums (and salts used in heat treatment where provided)
5. Ability to read and set pyrometers as well as setting of temperature controls where provided.
6. Ability to use hardness tester will be an advantage.

24. ELECTROPLATOR

1. Shall be familiar with the use of acids, alkalies and other materials used in pickling, degreasing/cleaning or etching process on which he is engaged and the risk involved, thereto. Should have elementary knowledge on the use of acids and alkalies.
2. Ability to prepare materials for galvanizing. Knowledge of melting metal in galvanizing bath during galvanizing and of heating articles to the temperatures required for galvanizing.
3. Should be able to judge by visual or other examination whether the pickling, cleaning or etching process has been properly carried out and he should be practically conversant with the process.
4. Ability to use scratch brush muff for polishing of plated job.
5. Ability to connect parts to electrodes according to instructions.

SELECTION:

The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. The selection process will comprise of written test of 100 marks and trade test (Practical) of 100 marks. All eligible candidates will be called for an objective type written test. On the basis of merit of written test marks, candidates will be called for trade test (Practical test) of 100 marks in the ratio of 1:3 to the number of vacancies. Final merit will be decided on the basis of combined marks in the written and practical test.

APPLICATION FEE

1. An application fee of Rs.50/- (Rupees Fifty Only) is payable by the candidates
2. SC/ST/XSM/PH candidates are exempted from payment of application fee.
3. The Application fee is non-refundable.
4. The application fee should be paid through Crossed Indian Postal Order or Demand Draft drawn in favour of The General Manager, Engine Factory Avadi.
5. The Postal Order should be issued after the date of publication of the advertisement and issuing date of Postal Order should be indicated clearly.
6. The candidates seeking relaxation in fees must enclose copy of their caste certificate/disability certificate/discharge certificate attested by a Gazetted Officer alongwith application forms.

PAYMENT OF TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE:

The candidates appearing for the Written Examination shall travel at their own expenses. However SC/ST candidates shall only once be paid travelling allowance of Second class Railway/Bus fare, chargeable by the shortest on production of journey details including Railway tickets by the shortest route.

This concession is not admissible to those SC/ST candidates who are already in service in the Central Government or in a State Government or in a PSU etc. under the Central/State Government including Ordnance Factories Organisation.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLY

1. The candidates should read the instructions given in the website carefully before filling up the application.
2. The candidates shall apply for the above posts through **online only**. The website address for online registration is <https://efa.cloudapp.net> (User Name: user & Password: Password1*) The last date for online registration would be 21 (Twenty One) days from the date of publication of this advertisement in the Employment News. The candidates should fill up all the columns in the application, then click submit button and should take a print of their submitted application.

3. After submitting and taking print of the “filled” online application, the candidates should forward a copy of the same alongwith the certificates to “The General Manager, Engine Factory Avadi”. The candidate should affix a recent passport size photograph (not more than 3 months old) duly self attested partially on the photograph and partially on application and enclose two more copies of same photograph duly self attested on front side with Application number and name & Post written on the backside. Thereafter, the candidate should sign and put the left thumb impression at different places on the printed application as mentioned. It is very important that the photograph pasted on the front page and the left thumb impression and the signature of the candidate should cleanly and clearly fall **within** the specified boxes on the printed application. All the certificates should be attested by Gazetted Officers only. Applications should be addressed to The General Manager, Engine Factory, Avadi, Chennai – 600 054.
4. The online registration will be open from 30.01.2012 and will be closed on 20.02.2012. Printed applications will be accepted by the Factory upto 27.02.2012.
5. On the left corner of the envelope, application number and name of the post applied for should be written in bold letters.
6. The application must be enclosed with the following documents, otherwise, it will be rejected summarily and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard:-
 - a. Copies of the required certificates (Educational, Caste etc.) duly attested by a Gazetted Officer. In case of the OBC candidates, the caste certificate should be the latest and include the clause of non-creamy layer.
 - b. Self attested photo pasted on application and signed by the candidate partially on the photograph and partially on the application.
 - c. Two additional self-signed (on the front side) passport size photos of the same attached to the application.
 - d. Proof of Date of birth duly attested by a Gazetted Officer.
 - e. Indian Postal Order/DD o Rs.50/- for General and OBC candidates.
7. For knowing the date of written test and printing Examination Hall ticket, candidates can keep verifying the same website.
8. The following applications will be summarily rejected:-
 - a. Application without Postal Order/DD
 - b. Application without signature, thumb impression of the candidate
 - c. Application in other than prescribed proforma as per the advertisement.
 - d. Application received through FAX.
 - e. Application received after due date for any reason.
 - f. Incomplete applications.

 - h. Application not confirming/fulfilling to the required specifications/eligibility criteria will also be rejected.

9. Only selected candidates will be informed of their selection for the trade test in due course.
10. Candidates already in service in Central Government Department/State Government Department/ Semi Government Department must submit his/her applications through proper channel alongwith the certificate from his Head of Officer/Establishment that not vigilance or disciplinary case is pending or contemplated against him.
11. No interim query/correspondence of any kind by any means regarding the recruitment process including about the candidature or termination/cancellation of candidature or selection of appointment shall be entertained at any stage on any grounds whatsoever.

15. The General Manager reserves the right to increase/decrease the number of vacancies depending upon the actual requirement without any notice and these vacancies are further subject to any subsequent order of Court/MoD/Ordnance Factory Board.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place of work for the selected and appointed candidates will be Engine Factory, Avadi, Chennai – 600 054. But the services are liable to be transferred to any Ordnance Factory/Unit in India.
2. If a candidate is working in/under Central/State Government/PSUs etc., he must enclose NOC in original from his employer alongwith his Printed Application Form as provided for in the advertisement alongwith the certificate from his Head of Office/Establishment that no vigilance or disciplinary case is pending or contemplated against him/her.

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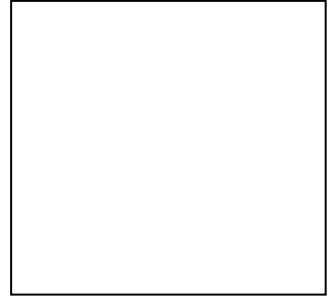
3. Exservicemen should submit their Printed Application Form alongwith a copy of Discharge certificate duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or equivalent authority, otherwise their application will not be considered. The Ex-servicemen will be eligible for age relaxation as per rules. They may be considered alongwith other candidates if otherwise found suitable.
4. The Physcially Handicapped persons having 40% disability identified suitable for the post may also apply for the post. They should submit a copy of Disability certificate for the PHPs in the prescribed format issued by Competent Medical Authorities, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or equivalent authority. The PHPs will be eligible for age relaxation as per rules. They may be considered along with other candidates if otherwise found suitable.


