1. Indian Air Force offers opportunities for **UNMARRIED MALE INDIAN CITIZENS** from the designated Districts of State of Chhattisgarh to join as Airmen. The Recruitment Test for Group 'X' (Technical) Trades, Group 'Y' (Medical Assistant) Trade and Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (For Automobile Technician, Ground Training Instructor (GTI) and Indian Air Force (Police) [IAF(P)] only) Trades will be held at Padmashri Govind Ram Nirmalkar Auditorium, Gaurav Path, Rajnandgaon (Chhattisgarh) from 17 December 2015 to 22 December 2015 as per the Selection Programme given below.

2. **SELECTION PROGRAMME.** The Recruitment Test will be conducted from 7 AM onwards as per the details given below. Candidates (from respective Districts covered below) reporting up to 10 AM on 17 & 19 December 2015 at the Rally Venue will only be permitted to appear in the Recruitment Test. (THE RECRUITMENT TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICERS/PILOTS/NAVIGATORS).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

9. **Tenure & Training.** Enrolment is for an initial period of 20 years extendable up to the age of 57 years (subject to service conditions). Initially candidates will be sent for a Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) at Basic Training Institute, Belagavi (Karnataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be allocated trades and sent for trade training of specified durations. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unfit. **AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF TRAINING, THE AIRMEN WILL BE DEPLOYED ON GROUND BASED JOBS AS PER THEIR ALLOTTED TRADES. ALLOTTED TRADE WILL NOT BE CHANGED ON CANDIDATE'S REQUEST ON ANY GROUNDS.**

10. **Pay & Allowances.** During training, a stipend of Rs. 11,400/- per month will be paid. On completion of training the starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay including Grade Pay, Military Service Pay (MSP), Group 'X' Pay (applicable for Group 'X' (Technical) Trades only) and Dearness Allowance (DA) will be as follows:-

(a) **Group 'X' (Technical) Trades.** Rs. 24,900/- per month (approximately) which, in subsequent years, may rise up to Rs. 43,940/- per month (approximately).

(b) **Group 'Y' (Med Asst) Trade and Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (For Automobile Technician, GTI and IAF(P) only) Trades.** Rs. 20,500/- per month (approximately) which, in subsequent years, may rise up to Rs. 38,720/- per month (approximately).

11. Other allowances such as Transport allowance, Technical Allowance (applicable for Group 'X' (Technical) Trades only), Composite personal maintenance allowance (CPMA), Leave Ration allowance (LRA), Children Education Allowance, Family planning allowance, HRA etc. are also admissible to airmen. **Note.** The above pay & allowances are under revision.

12. **Perks.** Perks such as Ration, Clothing, Medical facilities, Accommodation, CSD(Canteen) facilities, Leave (60 days Annual and 30 days Casual in a Calendar year as a privilege), Recreational facilities, Transport for school going children and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) are also provided as per the existing rules. Notwithstanding the above, **Group Insurance** Cover of Rs. 25, 00,000/- at a premium of Rs. 1,630/- per month is covered for all airmen and facility of Group Housing Scheme is also extended. Other facilities by **Air Force Wives Welfare Association (AFWWA)** are also extended to the family of airmen.

Job Specification

(a) **Group 'X' (Technical) Trades involve jobs as given below:**

(i) **Automobile Fitter.** In this trade you are responsible for maintenance and repair of all type of light and heavy duty mechanical vehicles, cranes and loading equipment etc. (ii) **Electronics Fitter.** As an Electronics Fitter you operate and maintain Radar, Voice and Data transmission and reception equipment mounted on latest airborne weapon delivery systems and ground based air defense systems. You will get trained in Digital Electronics, measuring instruments, radar technology, latest electronics devices and related trade fundamentals. (iii) **Electrical Fitter.** You will maintain power supply system of latest types of aircraft, airborne missiles and associated ground systems. You will also maintain photo equipment mounted on air borne weapon systems and operate ground based photo systems. You will get trained in electrical trade, operation and maintenance of digital devices, electronic devices etc. (iv) **Mechanical System Fitter.** You will repair and maintain mechanical, hydraulic and pneumatic systems of airborne missiles, engines, automobiles and aircraft fuelling equipment. Complete aircraft ground support equipment will also be repaired and maintained by you. You will be trained in handling and preparation of bombs and explosives and in electrical system, workshop and mechanical trades as well as automobile mechanics. (v) **Structure Fitter.** As Structure Fitter you are responsible for the maintenance and servicing of airframes and their accessories, components and controls of aircraft. Regular checks for the entire hydraulic and pneumatic system to ensure proper functioning against leaks are also part of your duties. You will also be assigned the responsibility of marshaling, parking, picketing and ground handling of aircraft. (vi) **Propulsion Fitter.** In this trade you will repair, maintain and prepare for use the propulsion system of aircraft and other airborne weapon delivery system. (vii) **Workshop Fitter (Smith).** You will undertake major structural repairs of all aircraft at central repair facilities. You will also be trained in workshop trade for material treatment, welding, heat treatment, smithy and basic machine tools etc. (viii) **Workshop Fitter (Mechanical).** You will undertake repair and maintenance work of mechanical nature. You will be trained in workshop trade and practices. (ix) **Weapon Fitter.** In this trade, you will prepare, maintain and service armaments, ammunition and safety equipment of aircraft, missiles and other weapon delivery systems. You will also operate and maintain small arms and bomb destruction equipment. You will be trained to handle bombs, explosives, arms and their installation on weapon delivery platforms.

(b) **Group 'Y' (Med Asst) Trade.** As a Medical Assistant you are made familiar with Nursing and First-aid. You are also involved in Management of Medical Stores, Dispensaries and Ward supervision.

(c) **Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (For Automobile Technician, GTI and IAF(P) only) Trades** involve jobs as given below:

(i) **Automobile Technician.** As an Automobile Technician you will drive all types of light, medium and heavy automobiles, load carriers and specialist vehicles like cranes, towing tractors, fork lifters etc., subject to service exigencies. You will also carry out minor repairs, day to day maintenance and basic level servicing of the common user vehicles and specialist vehicles in the Indian Air Force inventory. (ii) **Ground Training Instructor.** As a Ground Training Instructor, you will train personnel on drill, parade, handling of arms and physical exercise. You are also responsible for organizing and conducting all games and sports activities. (iii) **Indian Air Force (Police).** As an Indian Air Force (Police) your responsibilities involve assuming police duties and investigation of offences. You are also in-charge of maintenance of security.

Note: Group 'X' and Group 'Y' Airmen will also have to undertake any other tasks as assigned by superior authorities.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

14. **Verification of Eligibility.** Original Certificates, Marks Sheets and other required applicable original/duly filled documents like NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' certificate, Son of serving Air Force personnel (SOAFP) certificate (or) PPO, Discharge Book, Service Certificate issued from DAV/AFRO for Sons of retired/deceased/discharged Air Force personnel (or) Discharge Certificate (if discharged from Army/Naval/Government organisation), Consent Form signed by parents if candidate below 18 years of age and passport size colour photographs will be required and scrutinized/verified at the examination venue prior to commencement of Written Test to ascertain the eligibility in prima-facie. Detailed verification will be carried out later in respect of candidates who pass Written Test. Candidature of those who do not meet the laid down educational criteria is liable to be rejected during **Initial verification of original certificates & mark sheets** prior to conduct of written test and also during **detailed verification** on clearing the written test.

Note: The original Passing Certificates / Marks Sheets will not be retained by the Selection Centre. The same will be returned to the candidates on completion of detailed verification.

SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION

15. **Written Test.** Written Test will be objective type and question paper will be bilingual (English & Hindi) except for English paper. Detailed procedure shall be explained before conduct of the examination. Written Test and Duration of the Test will be as follows: -

(a) **Group 'X' (Technical) Trades.** Duration of the written test will be **60 minutes** and will comprise of **English, Physics and Mathematics** as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus.

(b) **Group 'Y' (Med Asst) Trade and Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (For Automobile Technician, GTI and IAF(P) only) Trades.** Duration of the written test will be **45 minutes** and will comprise of **English** as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and **Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).**

CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER SEPARATELY. Results of the written test will be declared on the same day.

16. **Adaptability Test.** All candidates who pass the Written Test will have to undertake Adaptability Test as per policy in vogue.

17. **Physical Fitness Test (PFT).** All candidates who pass the Written Test and Adaptability Test are to undergo **Physical Fitness Test (PFT)** on the same or the next day. PFT consists of a **1.6 Km** run to be completed within **8 minutes**. Candidates will also have to complete **20 squats** followed by **10 push-ups** and **10 sit-ups** within the stipulated time to qualify in the **Physical Fitness Test**. Candidates are advised to bring their **sports shoes** and shorts.

18. **Interview.** Candidates who have passed the Written Test, Adaptability Test and PFT will be interviewed. Working knowledge of English is a pre-requisite.

19. **Medical Examination.** Candidates who qualify in the interview will be medically examined in the month of **January 2016**. Medical Examination will be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards and existing policy in vogue. Medical Examination would also include Baseline Investigation of: -

- (a) Hb, TLC, DLC (c) Urea, Uric Acid and Creatinine (e) Serum Cholesterol (g) ECG (R)
- (b) Blood Sugar Fasting/PP (d) Serum bilirubin, SGOT, SGPT (f) X-Ray chest PA view (Plain)

Candidates declared Medically Unfit can avail the option for Appeal Medical Board (AMB) against their Unfitness by depositing Rs. 40/- in a Government Treasury/RBI/SBI through Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of MRO, photocopy of Unfitness Certificate and Postal Stamp worth Rs. 25/- affixed on a self-addressed envelope are to be submitted at **MBC (Medical Board Centre), 3 Air Force Hospital, Amla** within three working days from the date of issue of Medical Unfitness Certificate.

Note 1: Candidates should bring latest prescription (one month validity) and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The prescription must bear the signature, stamp and registration number of eye specialist.

Note 2: Candidates are advised to get tartar & stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the medical examination. Ears should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to travel / stay for the medical test for four to five days under their own arrangement. No TA/DA will be admissible.

20. **Publishing of AISL.** The All India Select List (AISL) will be displayed at **15 Airmen Selection Centre, Second Floor, Phase-II, Rajiv Gandhi Parisar, 35 Shyamala Hills, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh - 462002** on **30 April 2016**. Copies of the Display List will be sent to District Magistrate of Rajnandgaon (Chhattisgarh) (through Airmen Selection Centre) and will also be available at Central Airmen Selection Board website www.airmenselection.gov.in. The inclusion of names of the candidates in the AISL depends upon the performance of the candidates in the Rally. **Inclusion of name in the All India Select List (AISL) does not guarantee automatic enrolment.** Enrolment is strictly in order of merit from the AISL subject to medical fitness, availability of vacancies, not exceeding the age of 21 years on date of enrolment and meeting laid down eligibility criteria as and when called for enrolment. The validity of AISL will be 12 months from the date of display and will be applicable only for Intake No.02/2016 & 01/2017.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

3. **Date of Birth Block.**
(a) Candidates born between **01 February 1996** to **31 May 1999** (both days inclusive) are eligible to appear in the Recruitment Rally.
(b) In case, a candidate clears the Selection Procedure then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment is 21 years.

Educational Qualification

(a) **For Group 'X' (Technical) Trades.**

(i) Passed Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

(ii) Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology / Information Technology) from a Government recognized Polytechnic Institute with 50% marks in overall aggregate, and 50% marks in English in Diploma or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Diploma Course.

(b) **For Group 'Y' (Med Asst) Trade.** Passed Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

(c) **For Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (For Automobile Technician, GTI & IAF(P) only) Trades.**

(i) Passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects approved by Central / State Education Boards with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

(ii) Passed Two years Vocational Course recognized by Association of Indian Universities (CBSE / Board of Vocational Higher Secondary Education Kerala) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course.

Note: Exact aggregate % of marks before decimal as written in the marks sheet of 10+2/Intermediate/Equivalent/Two years Vocational Course/Three years Diploma Course OR calculated as per the rules of concerned Education Board/Polytechnic Institute will only be considered (For example 49.99% should be taken as 49% and not to be rounded off to 50%).

5. **Domicile Requirement.** To be eligible to appear in the rally at Padmashri Govind Ram Nirmalkar Auditorium, Gaurav Path, Rajnandgaon (Chhattisgarh) the candidates are required to satisfy the following conditions:

(a) Boards recognized/affiliated by Council of Boards for School Education (COBSE) and Association of Indian Universities (AIU) will only be permitted. (b) The School / College / Institute from where candidates have passed the qualifying examination should be within the geographical / administrative limits of State of Chhattisgarh. If the name of District is not mentioned with the name of Institution in the certificate / marks sheet of qualifying examination, the candidates are to produce 'Domicile Certificate' issued by Tehsildar/Nb Tehsildar or any official authorised by the State Government of Chhattisgarh. (c) Permanent Domicile of State of Chhattisgarh who have passed the qualifying examination from anywhere in India. However, such candidates have to produce the Domicile Certificate prior to commencement of examination from appropriate authority as given in sub-paragraph 5(b) above. (d) Sons of Serving Air Force Personnel, irrespective of their domicile status may be permitted to appear in the rally subject to submission of Son of serving Air Force personnel (SOAFP) certificate (format available on AFNET CASB website) (or) PPO, Discharge Book, Service Certificate issued from DAV/AFRO for Sons of retired/deceased/discharged Air Force personnel, in the following categories: - (i) Father/Mother is presently serving in any Air Force Unit located in the State of Chhattisgarh. (ii) Ex-IAF personnel/families of deceased personnel who are residing in the State of Chhattisgarh (on production of proof of minimum stay of one year along with Original and a photocopy of Discharge Book, Service Certificate issued from DAV/AFRO for wards of retired/deceased/discharged Air Force personnel).

Medical Standards.

(a) **General Medical Standards for Group 'X' (Technical) Trades, Group 'Y' (Med Asst) Trade and Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (For Automobile Technician, GTI & IAF(P) only) Trades** are as follows: -

(i) **Chest :** Minimum range of expansion: 5 cm. (ii) **Weight :** Proportionate to height and age. (iii) **Corneal Surgery (PRK/LASIK)** not acceptable. (iv) **Hearing :** Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters with each ear separately. (v) **Dental :** Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. (vi) **Health :** Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss of any appendages. He should be free from all communicable diseases and skin ailments. Candidate must be physically and mentally FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain. (vii) **Body Tattoo :** Permanent body tattoos on inner face of the fore arms (inside of elbow to the wrist), Back (dorsal) part of the hand/reverse side of palm and Tribals with tattoos which are as per custom and traditions of their tribes only are permitted. However, right to decide on acceptability/ unacceptability of the individual rests with the Selection Centre. **Candidates with permanent body tattoos are to submit a photograph of the tattoo with details of size and type of the Tattoo.**

(b) **Height, Leg Length, Visual Standards and Colour Vision for Group 'X' (Technical) Trades, Group 'Y' (Med Asst) Trade and Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (For Automobile Technician, GTI & IAF(P) only) Trades** are as follows: -

7. Candidates discharged from Indian Army/Indian Navy/Any other Government Organisation are also eligible subject to their discharge with **NO ADVERSE ENTRIES** (Original Discharge Certificate to be produced at the rally venue on the day of testing). **Candidates discharged from Indian Air Force for any reason are not eligible to appear in the rally.**

8. **Writing Materials and Documents Required.** Candidates are to bring the following:-

(a) HB Pencil, Eraser, Sharpener, Gum tube, Stapler and Black/Blue Ball Point Pen for writing. (b) Seven un-attested recent (taken not before November 2015) passport size colour photograph (front portrait in light background without head gear except for Sikhs). The photograph is to be taken with candidate holding a black slate in front of his chest with his Name and Date of Photograph taken, clearly written on it with white chalk in capital letters. (c) Original and four self-attested photocopies of **Matriculation Passing Certificate** (required for Date of Birth verification). (d) Original and four self-attested photocopies of **Matriculation Marks Sheet** (Only applicable for 03 years Diploma Course / 02 years Vocational Course Holders when English is not a subject in Diploma Course/Vocational Course). (e) Original and four self-attested photocopies of **Intermediate/10+2 Equivalent Examination Passing Certificate and Marks Sheet.** OR Original and four self-attested photocopies of **Three years Diploma Course/Two years Vocational Course Passing Certificate and Marks Sheets of all semesters** for Diploma / Vocational Course Holders (as applicable). (f) Original and four self-attested photocopies of Domicile Certificate (or) Original and four self-attested photocopies of duly filled Son of Air Force personnel (SOAFP) Certificate (format available on AFNET CASB website) for Sons of serving Air Force personnel (or) Original and four self-attested photocopies of PPO/ Discharge Book/ Service Certificate issued from DAV/AFRO for Sons of retired/deceased/discharged Air Force personnel (or) Original and four self-attested photocopies of Discharge Certificate if applicable (as issued from Indian Army/Indian Navy/Government Organisation).
