2. RELAXATION IN AGE LIMIT

Code. No	Category	Age relaxation permissible beyond the upper age limit
1.	General	No age relaxation
2.	SC/ ST	5 years
3.	OBC	3 years
4.	Central Govt. Employee	5 years in upper age limit provided they have rendered a minimum of 3 years continuous service in the Government of India Offices/ Departments on posts in the same line/allied cadre as on last date of receipt of application and continue to be in such service till their appointment in Cabinet Secretariat.

5.	J&K Migrant	Candidates of Jammu & Kashmir who have ordinarily been domiciled in the state of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 1.1.1980 to 31.12.1989 will be eligible for grant of age relaxation in the upper age limit up to a maximum of 5 years.
6.	Ex-Servicemen	(i) 5 years in case of ex-servicemen including Commissioned Officers and ECOs/SSCOs who have rendered at least five years Military service as on last date of receipt of application. (ii) Upto a maximum three years in the case of Defence services personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof. (iii) Upto a maximum of five years in the case of ECOs/SSCOs who have completed an initial period of assignment of five years Military Service as on last date of receipt of application and whose assignment has been extended beyond five years and in whose case the Ministry of Defence issued a certificate that they can apply for civil employment and that they will be released on three months' notice of selection from the date of receipt of offer of appointment.

Note:

Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes who are also covered under any other clauses of para 2 above, viz. those coming under the category of Ex-servicemen and persons domiciled in the State of J&K and Central Government Employees will be eligible for grant of cumulative age relaxation under both the categories.

3. Candidates fulfilling the eligibility conditions of educational qualification, age etc. and having a minimum of 50% marks in GATE in one of the following subject papers with a valid GATE score card as on the closing date, will be eligible to apply for the under-mentioned posts.

Note:-

- i) Interested & eligible candidates desirous to apply for the above posts may appear for one of the above mentioned subject paper of GATE 2017.
- ii) The candidate must have a valid GATE Score Card as on the last date of receipt of applications irrespective of the year of GATE exam in which they appeared.

4. **SELECTION PROCESS**

The selection for direct recruitment to these posts will be based on the valid GATE marks out of 100 and personal interview carrying 25 marks respectively. A candidate has to secure minimum qualifying marks of 40% in Personal Interview.

5. **SCRUTINY OF APPLICATION AND SHORTLISTING OF ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR INTERVIEW**

All the applications received in response to the recruitment notification will be scrutinised as per eligibility criteria. Thereafter, all eligible candidates will be arranged in the order of merit according to marks secured in GATE exam. Out of eligible candidates, only five times the number of vacancies will be called for personal interview, according to merit.

6. **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTRATION/APPLICATION**

- (i) Candidates willing to be considered for the above posts are advised to register themselves and appear in GATE examination 2017.

- (iii) Online Registration for GATE 2017 shall commence on 1st September 2016.
- (iv) Advertisement to call for applications of the candidates with valid GATE score card will be issued after declaration of the result of GATE- 2017.

7. **GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS**

- (i) Only Indian Nationals are eligible to apply for the above posts.
- (ii) Candidates should possess the prescribed eligibility condition of educational qualifications, age, valid GATE Score Card in the requisite subject paper etc. as on the closing date, which will be mentioned in detailed advertisement to be published after declaration of the GATE 2017 results.
- (iii) A candidate can apply for more than one post subject to his/her fulfilling the eligibility conditions.
- (iv) Medical Standard of the candidates would be as per the Central Govt. guidelines applicable to Group 'A' posts.
